## **Morning Carline Procedure**

- Students must be wearing a mask covering the mouth and nose when they exit the car.
- 2. Students Temperature will be taken as they enter the building.
- 3. Students will proceed to their 1st-period classroom.
- 4. When dropping off students, pull <u>ALL THE WAY FORWARD</u> to the end of the sidewalk.

The student drop off zone is from the end of the sidewalk by the High School exit doors, back to the main entrance doors.

- 5. Students should be prepared to exit the car, having already gathered up any necessary materials.
- 6. <u>For the safety of your child and others, never let a child enter or exit the car on the</u> driver's side.
- 7. In order to allow our carline drop-off to flow, <u>do not park and exit your car</u>.

Students should be dropped off *no sooner then 7:30 am and no later than 7:55 am* in order to be in the classroom and ready to learn by 8:00 am.
