

1) Kroger Community Rewards Program

Link your Kroger's Plus Shopper's Card to the Spring Valley Academy Kroger Community Rewards account. A percentage of everything supporters spend at Kroger will go to SVA each quarter. Your spending information is 100% confidential and Kroger does not share this information with any organization which it funds.

- Under "My Account" use your email address/password to proceed to the next step.
- Click on "Edit Kroger Community Rewards" and input your Kroger Plus card number.
- Enter NPO # NX823, select Spring Valley Academy from list and click confirm.

*Enrolling in this program **DOES NOT** affect your fuel points earnings.


Kroger Plus cards are available at the customer service desk at any Kroger.

2) Box Tops for Education
